Thrive in the jungle, summit the magnificent peak of Mt Kinabalu and kick back on tropical island beaches. Borneo is home to one of the oldest rainforests in the world, the highest peak in Southeast Asia and one of only two places on the planet where orangutans roam wild. Get involved in wildlife conservation, working alongside rangers to rescue and rehabilitate Bornean sun bears and collaborate with local ethnic groups to pipe clean water into rural rainforest communities. Find a new angle; bike off the beaten track in the Kulu valley, experience the jungle with survival experts in Bario and live local in a traditional longhouse.

A Borneo expedition will take you the full length of the island from Sarawak to Sabah, from Kuching to Kota Kinabalu. Go fast, go slow; pump up the adrenaline with white water rafting, high ropes and zip wiring and make time to hit the beach, snorkel tropical islands and catch the sunset.
