



COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS): VISITOR POLICY

In response to the coronavirus pandemic, St Peter's School, York has implemented a strict COVID-Secure visitor policy to safeguard the health and wellbeing of the whole school community.

Our policy has been developed in accordance with the advice and guidance given by Public Health England (PHE), the Boarding Schools' Association (BSA), and the DofE's guidance document '[Schools coronavirus\(COVID-19\) operational guidance September 2021](#)', supported by our in-house medical team.

To protect all in the school community, we would ask anyone who meets the following criteria not to visit the school until they have completed the specified self-isolation period and are symptom-free.

Please do not visit the school if you have a high temperature and / or new continuous cough and / or loss of taste or smell (or other symptoms of COVID-19) or have had a positive COVID-19 test within the last 11* days.

Do not visit the school if you have been in close contact with anyone who has these symptoms and / or has had a positive COVID-19 test in the last 11* days, unless you are under 18.5 years or are fully vaccinated and have had a negative PCR test. [* First day of symptoms or the day of a COVID test + 10 days]

If you have arrived in the UK from abroad, you must have complied with the government's rules for [Travel to England](#), isolated where required (if travelling from a red list country or if not fully vaccinated) and had a negative COVID 19 test result(s) at the prescribed times.

On arrival at School, visitors must sanitise their hand upon entry and report to the relevant School Reception.

Delivery drivers must only come to the Estates department via the Rise gates.

Face masks / face coverings are required in all communal areas of the school, and visitors are asked to bring their own with them.
