St Peter's School
3-18YORK

Set in almost fifty acres of verdant grounds stretching to the banks of the River Ouse, St Peter's is only minutes away from the beauty and history of York's city centre.

Three schools, one campus



Clifton
3-8YORK

Clifton School and Nursery caters for boys and girls age 3 – 8. Nursery pupils have a suite of dedicated accommodation leading directly to a safe, welcoming grass play area, with a multitude of activities and facilities available. Older pupils occupy classrooms in the Chilman Building, just yards from the nursery. All pupils enjoy a full range of facilities at Clifton, which include an astro turf area for play and sports, a wildlife pond, a Forest School area, a library and a dining hall. In addition, pupils can make use of the sports facilities, theatre spaces, swimming pool and outdoor spaces afforded by the Senior School campus.



St Olave's
8-13YORK

St Olave's, for children aged 8-13, occupies the Queen Anne buildings at the south end of the campus. As well as classrooms and play areas, St Olave's has its own cookery, Design and Technology, Art, Music and Science facilities, two sports halls, grass and astro sports pitches, tennis courts, a quiet garden, a library, a vegetable garden and the Shepherd Hall, used for drama, music and assembly. Pupils make regular use of the swimming pool and attend chapel twice a week, and have access to other shared spaces and facilities on campus.



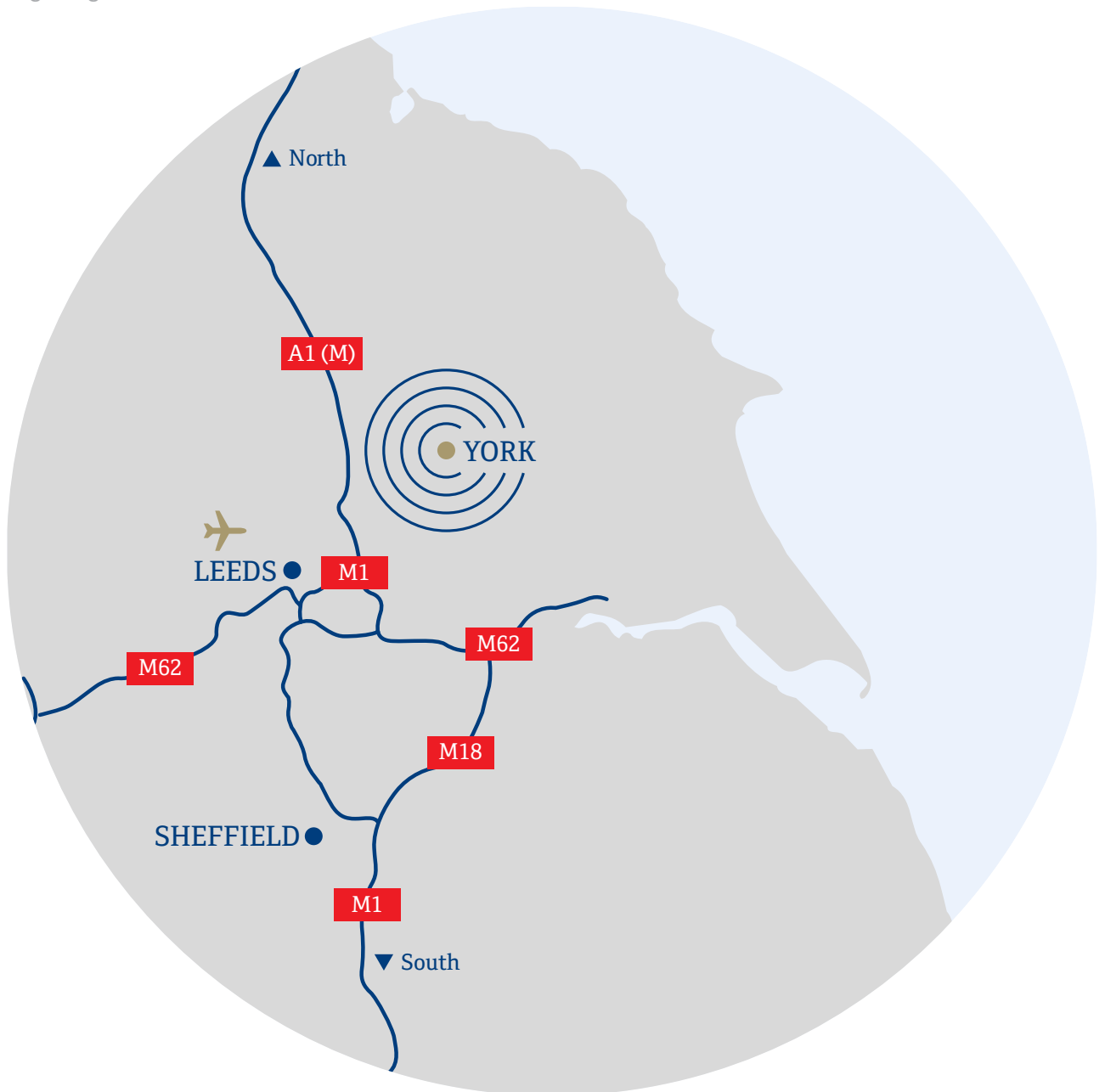
St Peter's
13-18YORK

St Peter's occupies a range of buildings, both historic and modern. Classroom facilities are complemented by the Memorial Hall, the school chapel, library, swimming pool and extensive sports grounds. The School boat house is situated on the banks of the River Ouse, giving pupils direct access to 14 miles of river.

The School's five boarding houses – Wentworth, for St Olave's pupils, and Dronfield, Linton, Manor and The Rise for pupils at St Peter's – are all located on or very close to the campus.

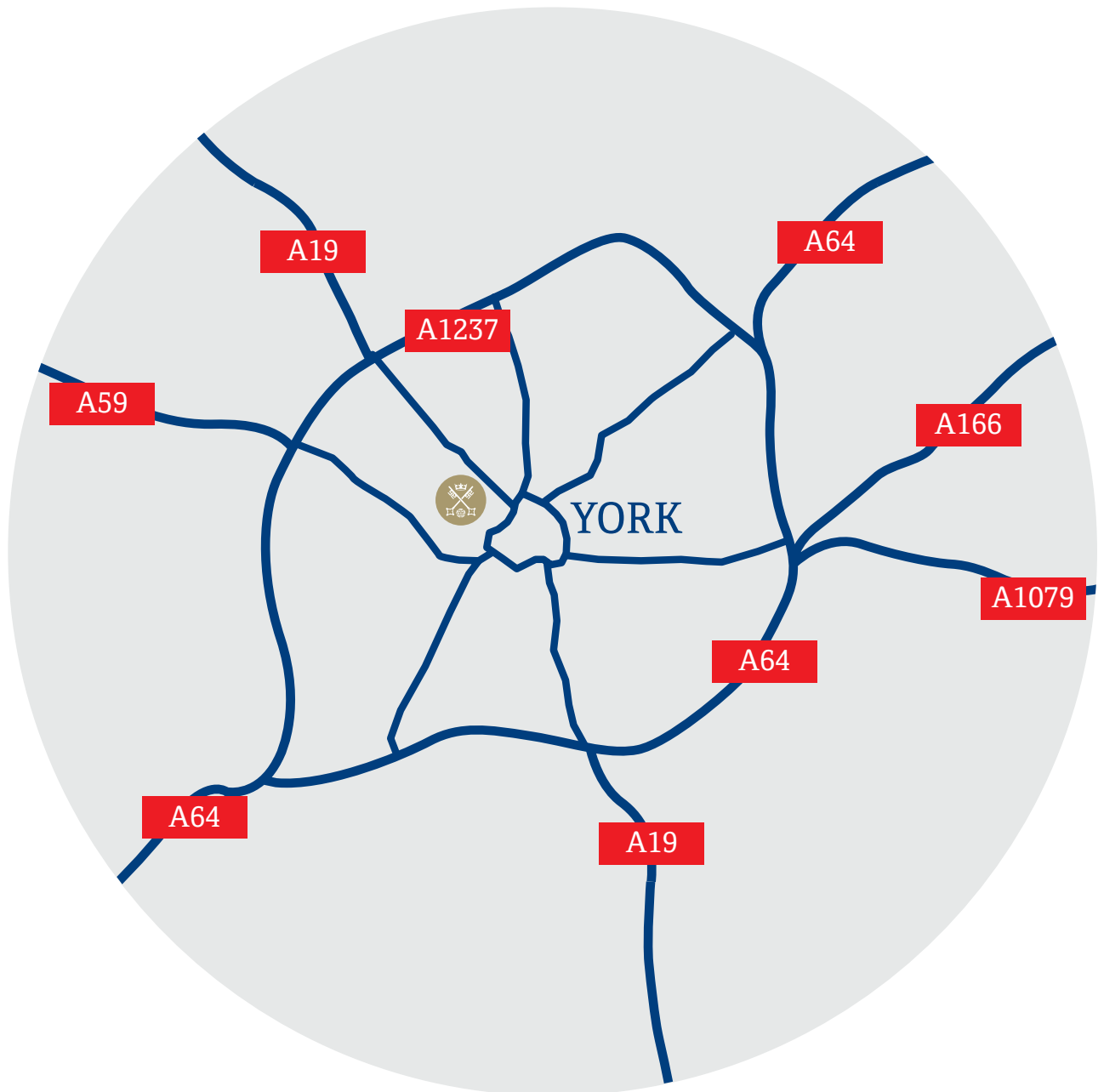
Perfectly connected

York is extremely accessible. For those travelling by car, the city is within easy reach of the A1 motorway. York Railway Station, a ten minute walk from the School, is on the East Coast main line, just an hour from Newcastle and less than two hours from London Kings Cross and Manchester Airport. Leeds Bradford International Airport is less than an hour away, and the School runs transfers at the beginning and end of term.



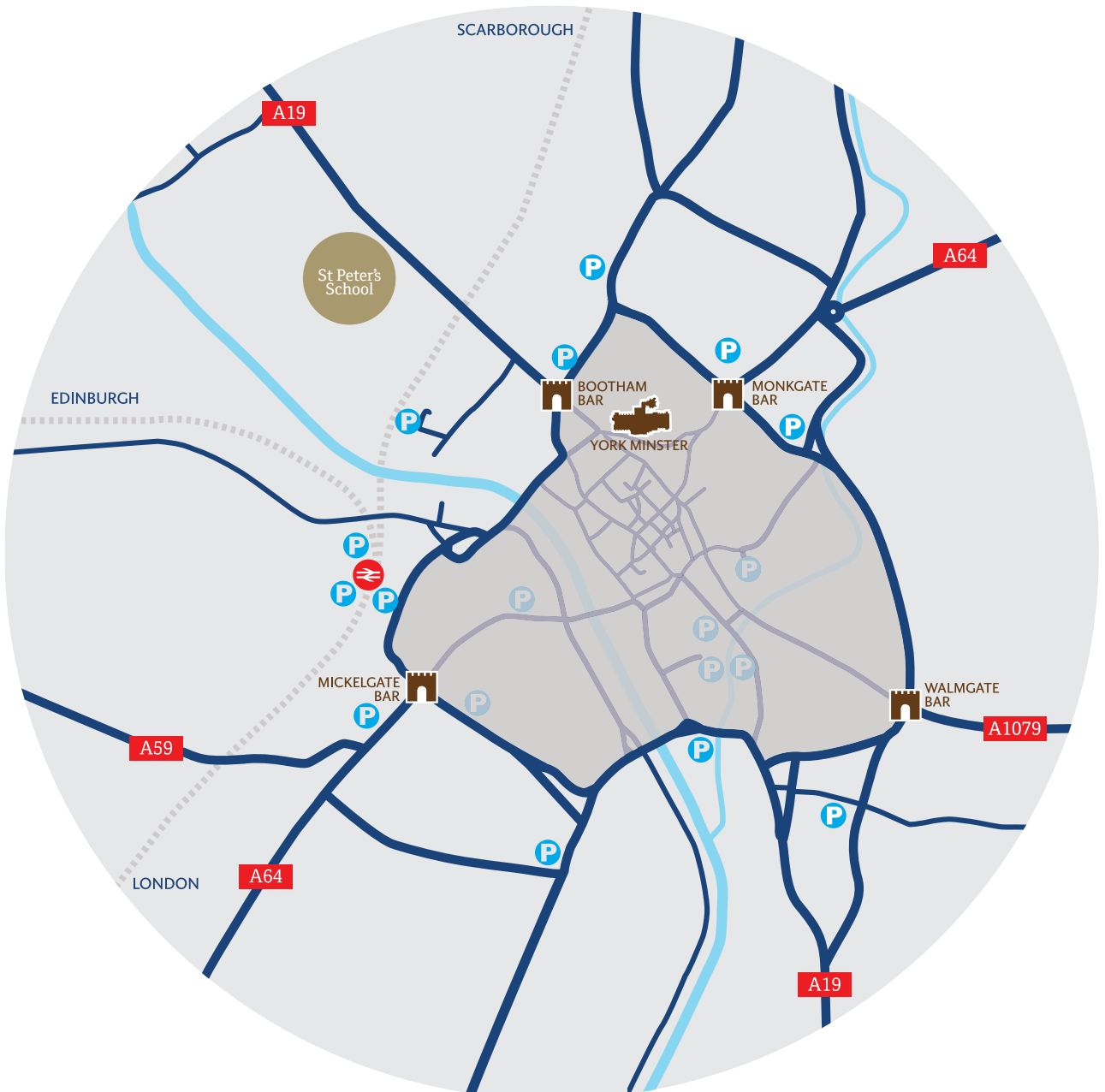
The Heart of Yorkshire

St Peter's School is just ten minutes on foot from York Railway Station, and from the city's historic Roman Walls and York Minster. As well as being accessible for pupils arriving by car or train, this proximity to the city centre gives our pupils superb access to the attractions and historic sights of York.
