Quicksilver – Britain's World Water Speed Record Challenge

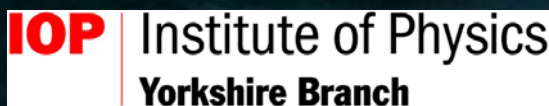
