Items listed below may be purchased from other sources but some are also available from Schoolblazer Ltd.

- White Long Sleeved and/or Short Sleeved Shirts
- Grey Socks
- Polishable Plain Black Shoes (either lace-up, velco or slip on – black laces only)
- *Gloves (optional – navy blue – not gauntlet style)*
- One draw string bag to hold PE kit (white sports shirt, white shorts & white socks) – any design allowed
- One Towel (for showering/Swimming)
- One pair Training Shoes for outdoor use (**no florescent or extreme colours**)
- One pair White Training/Gym Shoes for indoor use (amber or white soled)
- Rugby Boots (**no florescent or extreme colours**)
- Two pairs White Sports Socks (**not trainer socks**)
- Gum Shield
- Astro Shoes (Easter Term only for Hockey - strongly recommended for 'A' & 'B' team players in J3, J4 & J5)
- Shin Pads (Easter Term only for Hockey - it is recommended that they have ankle protectors)
- White Cricket Flannels (Summer Term – only if in school 'A' team in J3, J4 & J5)
- One pair White Cricket Boots (Summer Term – only if in school 'A' team in J3, J4 & J5)
- Cricket Box (Summer Term only)
- Cricket Equipment is provided for all year groups but J3, J4 & J5 boys may bring their own (Summer Term only)
- Rackets, Hockey Sticks and Cricket Bats are provided for all year groups but boys may bring their own (named)

Notes

1. All clothing, including boots and shoes, must be clearly labelled with surname and initials.
2. Pupils should take their swimming kit (or towel if used for showering) home after use for laundering and return it to school the following morning.
3. All games clothing should be brought in on a Monday morning and taken home for washing at regular intervals. Kit is often required for occasions outside the normal games programme.
4. Sports Jackets (or alternatively School Coats) must be in school every day ready for trips or walking to Chapel. **Blazers are to be worn when arriving at and leaving school.**
5. Boys' hair should be short (off the collar and above the ears) and business smart neat. Hair must be their natural colour (i.e. not dyed or highlighted), have no shaved patterns and the use of hair products is not permitted.
6. No hoodies are to be worn under blazers or as an alternative to the school jumper either in or out of school, and no alternative coats or gilets are to be worn. Accessories e.g. scarves, hats and gloves **must be plain and navy blue.**
7. No jewellery other than a watch may be worn.
8. Shirt sleeves are not allowed to be rolled up on long sleeve shirts – short sleeved option available.
9. If parents/guardians are in any doubt about the suitability or acceptability of an article of clothing or equipment, it is essential to consult the House Tutor before buying it.
