# Notes

1. Parents/Guardians are requested to place this list on top of the contents of the boarder's trunk and to cross out any optional articles which are not included.
2. It is essential to send the exact number of articles on the list.
3. All clothing must be clearly labelled with surname and initials.
4. All boots and shoes must be clearly named.
5. Long hair should be tied back with a **plain navy blue, black or brown band/bobble** only. Hair slides should be navy blue, black or brown only. Hair should remain tied back when in uniform e.g. when leaving school. Hair must be their natural colour (i.e. not dyed or highlighted) and the use of hair products is not permitted.
6. **No jewellery** other than a watch may be worn. Ears may be pierced once in each ear and plain gold or silver studs only may be worn. They must be removed for Games and PE.
7. All other personal possessions should be clearly and permanently marked.
8. The overnight bag is needed to hold what is required for the first night before trunks are unpacked, and for Exeat weekends and Half-Terms.
9. School skirt length should be to at least **just below the knee**.
10. Sports Jackets (or alternatively School Coats) must be in school every day ready for trips or walking to Chapel. **Blazers are to be worn when arriving at and leaving school.**
11. No hoodies are to be worn under blazers or as an alternative to the school jumper either in or out of school and no alternative coats or gilets are to be worn. Accessories e.g. scarves, hats and gloves **must be plain and navy blue**.
12. No makeup may be worn.
13. If parents/guardians are in any doubt about the suitability or acceptability of an article of clothing or equipment, it is essential to consult the Houseparent before buying it.
