The 2020/21 hire charge is £34 per term, which will be added to the school bill.

Students are expected to look after any school instrument that is in their care. Whilst the Music School will cover expenses incurred to the instrument due to reasonable natural wear and tear, any repairs that are necessitated by carelessness or negligence must be paid for by the student's parents. Any damaged instruments should be immediately returned to the music department, which will arrange for any necessary repairs to be undertaken. Under NO CIRCUMSTANCES should any repairs be attempted without full consultation with the music department.

Instruments may be hired for a period of one year once a pupil is playing on a full-size instrument. After that initial period, instruments should be returned to the school from which they were borrowed. J5 students at St Olave's may keep their instrument to practice with over the summer break, but they must return the instrument to St Olave's when they return to school in September and hire a different instrument from St Peter's Music School, for which a new hire form will need to be filled out.

In some cases it may be possible to extend the one-year hire period if, for example, the instrument is not required by another pupil.

Students should not borrow instruments or swap instruments between themselves without the prior knowledge of their music teachers.
