- Year 3 Recorder, piano, violin, guitar, flute, clarinet, pocket cornet (smaller version of a cornet/trumpet, once the child has grown enough they can transfer onto a full sized instrument easily) or pbone (lighter version of a trombone - students once grown enough can easily transfer onto a trombone from this instrument).

The fees for 2020/21 are:

£22 per 30-minute lesson. Hire charge of £34 per term where appropriate.
