St Peter's 8-13

Equipment

- 4 HB or H pencils
- rubber
- sharpener
- 30cm clear ruler (millimetres and centimetres)
- small semi-circular (180°) protractor
- 3 handwriting blue pens (not biro)
- 1 black handwriting pen
- 1 purple handwriting pen
- 2 different coloured highlighters
- coloured pencils
- glue stick
- small scissors
- no liquid Tippex permitted
- Electronic spellcheckers are very useful and should be clearly named in permanent ink. (In class we use Franklin spellcheckers). School do provide some of these for use in the classroom, so this is not compulsory, but children do find these particularly helpful in many subject areas, not just English. Please do shop around for these as prices vary enormously from approx. £20-40.

From Year 5 (J2) onwards

- a pair of compasses with a half pencil

From Year 6 (J3) onwards

- full circular protractor (not too big, clear)
- e.g. Helix 360° angle measurer

All items should be clearly named with a label, or initials scratched onto equipment, and contained in a named pencil case.

Calculators

All pupils at St Peter's 8-13 require the use of a calculator.

Year 4 and 5 (J1 and J2)

They will only require a basic calculator (not a scientific one please). It must satisfy the following requirements:

- a clear display
- no loud clicks when buttons are pressed
- looks as though it will not easily break
- the following functions: Memory (MR, M+, M-), =/- key, √, %

Year 6, 7 and 8 (J3, J4 and J5)

They will require a Scientific Calculator and J4 as they will use it for both mathematics and science. They need the Casio FX-83GT Plus Scientific Calculator, which is appropriate for GCSE, or the more advanced Casio FX-991EX Classwiz which is required at St Peter's for A Level and has advantages for GCSE.

Calculators

Pupils are required to have their own calculator. We strongly recommend the Casio fx-991CW, which is suitable for both GCSE and A-level Mathematics. Pupils will also require a standard Geometry set, including a Protractor and pair of compasses.

Please Note:

If a pupil does not have this particular calculator they could be disadvantaged in Maths lessons.

Please make sure that child's name is scratched onto the machine.

Lockers and Padlocks

Each Day pupil has a locker in a Common Room and a locker for games kit in the changing rooms. They must provide padlocks, one for each locker. Combination locks are preferable.
