- Cricket Equipment is provided for all year groups but J4 & J5 boys may bring their own (Summer Term only)
- Tennis racket
- Hockey stick
- A small backpack/rucksack for taking homework/pencil case/water bottle to and from school when required

Notes

- 1. All clothing, including boots and shoes, must be clearly labelled with surname and initials.
- 2. Pupils should take their swimming kit (or towel if used for showering) home after use for laundering and return it to school the following morning.
- 3. All games clothing should be brought in on a Monday morning and taken home for washing at regular intervals. Kit is often required for occasions outside the normal games programme.
- 4. Boys' hair should be short (off the collar and above the ears) and business smart neat. Hair must be their natural colour (i.e. not dyed or highlighted), have no shaved patterns and the use of hair products is not permitted.
- 5. Blazers are to be worn when arriving at and leaving school.
- 6. Sports Jackets must be in school every day ready for trips or walking to Chapel.
- 7. No mid-layer tops are to be worn under blazers or as an alternative to the school jumper either in or out of school. Accessories e.g. scarves, hats and gloves **must be plain and navy blue**.
- 8. No jewellery other than a watch may be worn.
- 9. Shirt sleeves are not allowed to be rolled up on long sleeve shirts short sleeved option available.
- 10. If parents/guardians are in any doubt about the suitability or acceptability of an article of clothing or equipment, it is essential to consult the House Tutor before buying it.
