## Items listed below may be purchased from other sources but some are also available from Schoolblazer Ltd.

- Grey Skirt (length to be at least just below the knee)
- Blue Long and/or Short Sleeved Blouses (to be worn with a tie, NOT rounded collar)
- Navy Blue Knee Length Socks or Plain Knit Tights
- Plain Black Shoes flat shoes

   (either lace-up, velcro or buckled to give maximum support black laces only, not trainers)
- One draw string bag to hold PE kit (white sports shirt, athletics shorts & white socks) – any design allowed
- One Towel (for showering/Swimming)
- One pair of trainers for outdoor use
- One pair of trainers for indoor use
- Astro Shoes
- Two pairs White Sports Socks
- Gum Shield
- Shin Pads (Easter Term only for Hockey it is recommended that they have ankle protectors) \*ESSENTIAL\*
- Plain Navy Swimsuit (Goggles recommended)
- Hockey Stick
- A small backpack/rucksack for taking homework/pencil case/water bottle to and from school when required

## Notes

- I. All clothing, including boots and shoes, must be clearly labelled with surname and initials.
- 2. Pupils should take their swimming kit (or towel if used for showering) home after use for laundering and return it to school the following morning.
- 3. All games clothing should be brought in on a Monday morning and taken home for washing at regular intervals. Kit is often required for occasions outside the normal games programme.
- 4. Mid-length (touching shoulders) and long hair should be tied back neatly with a plain navy blue, black or brown band/bobble only. Hair slides should be navy blue, black or brown only. Hair should remain neatly tied back when in uniform e.g. when leaving school. Hair must be their natural colour (i.e. not dyed or highlighted) and the use of hair products is not permitted.
- 5. No makeup may be worn.
- 6. No jewellery other than a watch may be worn. Ears may be pierced once in each ear and plain gold or silver studs only may be worn. They must be removed for Games and PE.
- 7. School skirt length should be to at least **just below the knee**.
- 8. Sports Jackets must be in school every day ready for trips or walking to Chapel. Blazers are to be worn when arriving at and leaving school.
- 9. No mid-layer tops are to be worn under blazers or as an alternative to the school jumper either in or out of school. Accessories e.g. scarves, hats and gloves **must be plain and navy blue**.
- 10. If parents/guardians are in any doubt about the suitability or acceptability of an article of clothing or equipment, it is essential to consult the House Tutor before buying it.
